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Nashville's Fleet One growing work force 10 percent

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Nashville's **Fleet One** is preparing to embark on a \$1.2 million expansion that will see its local workforce grow by 10 percent.

A building permit was issued Tuesday to allow Fleet One to expand its existing space in Antioch's Haywood Oaks East by 32,482 square feet, more than doubling their current space at 601 Bakertown Road.

According to **Stacey Bright**, Fleet One's vice president of marketing, the expansion will allow for the addition of about 25 new employees. Fleet One has 227 employees, all but ten of whom work in the Nashville area.

Fleet One provides fuel cards and payment systems that help businesses and government agencies track transportation costs.

It's been a year of rapid growth for Fleet One, which [announced a year ago plans to add 49 jobs](#) in Middle Tennessee.

As part of the expansion, Fleet One will overhaul its customer care department, add two senior positions to its factoring division and grow the company's sales force.

Construction will be handled by Commercial Industrial Construction, Inc. The permit valued construction costs at \$1.2 million. Bright said the new offices should be complete by June.

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
